

To request a tree removal from the Village Right of Way, please fill out and submit this form to The Village Manager.

"A Right of Way (ROW) is land controlled by public agencies that includes streets, alleys, public sidewalks, curbs, and the berm/green area, which is the area between the curb and sidewalk. The Village Department of Public Works manages the work within the Village's Right of Way."

The Village Manager will determine if an arborist should be hired to inspect the tree for disease or decay. If it is determined the tree is a hazard it will be removed **as soon as funding becomes available** this could take a while depending on the availability of the tree removal crew.

If the tree is not determined a hazard, the property owner requesting the tree removal will be required to provide proof of why it should be removed.
